**NEW** **Potash Corp**  
**Road Numbers POTX 1287 / 1660**

These 3-Bay ACF center flow covered hoppers were built at National Steel Car's plant in Hamilton, Ontario. The Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan contracted with National Steel Car Ltd. to produce 1,000 custom-built potash rail cars. They are numbered into series 1000 – 1999. They are painted salmon red with white lettering and ride on Barber roller bearing trucks. These cars are custom built for potash and are specifically designed to accommodate the weight and density of potash.

**NEW** **Milwaukee Road**  
**Road Number MILW 50220**

This 50' rib side box car is painted yellow with black lettering. It is equipped with Stanray X type roof panels which were unpainted roofs made of galvanized steel. It is from a 570-car (50000 – 50569) fleet and built in 1974 by Southern Iron and Equipment Co. of Atlanta, Georgia. This series was rated at 70 tons.

**NEW** **Chesapeake & Ohio<sup>®</sup>**  
**Road Number C&O 368973**

This 50' steel side, 14 panel, fixed end gondola was built in January of 1967. It was rebuilt in February 1976 at Raceland. It is painted black with yellow lettering and "Chessie Cat" herald. It was rated at 100 tons with capacities of 2155 cu ft. During rebuilding they had double troughs installed, 10 adjustable cross bars and 3 section removable cover added to protect their loads.

**NEW** **Burlington**  
**Road Number CB&Q 4515**

This Burlington Heavyweight Parlor car is painted Pullman green with Gold letters and rides on six wheel passenger trucks. "BURLINGTON" letters are stenciled across the top letter board and centered under the roof with reporting marks & RD# 4515 centered under the BURLINGTON letters. Built in the mid-1920s, heavyweights were re-built, re-painted and re-numbered in the 1940s and 50s.

This wood sheathed ice reefer is one of 12 cars built by General American in July 1925 for Quaker City. It was then leased to the Louisville Provision Company (LPCX). LPCX 207 is painted brown. It has a modern underframe and was painted for the "Southern Star" meat products.

**NEW** **Smithsonian Civil War Series**  
**Car #7: Emancipation Proclamation**

On January 1st 1863 President Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation which declared that all persons enslaved in the Confederate states were to be set free. While the Proclamation did not immediately end slavery throughout the states, many slaves were freed in certain areas on that day forward. It also created a significant shift in the war as Northerners now fought for the preservation of the Union and the abolition of slavery. Many freed slaves joined the Union forces and vitally contributed to the Union victory and their freedom.

This 40' standard box car with plug door and roofwalk is painted box car red with aluminum roof and reefer yellow sides. It bears the black Rocky herald (circa 1967) with black GREAT NORTHERN / Western Fruit Express lettering and dim data. It was built in March 1953, serviced in March 1968, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. A subsidiary of Great Northern, Western Fruit Express Company handled all of GN's requirements for refrigerated cars, icing facilities and the like and rostered the "insulated" box cars with RBWX reporting marks.

**Burlington Northern

Equipped with roller bearing trucks, this BN green 50' flat car with fishbelly side and side mount brake wheel can carry a lading weight of 158,300 lbs. Lettering is in white. Built in October 1965, it was serviced at the Texas and Pacific shops in August 1979 where it received its consolidated stencil box. The BN merged with Santa Fe on December 31, 1996, becoming BNSF.

The 3,898 cu ft., 122,000 capacity steel box car was used in BX express service and equipped with Allied full-cushion trucks.

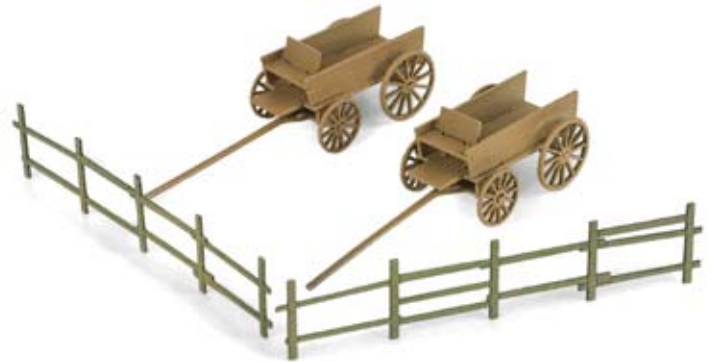

These 50' gondolas with fishbelly sides and drop ends were built in August 1957 by Pullman Standard. They were painted red with white lettering and black and white herald. They are part of a 200 car fleet. They were the first ones purchased by the GN to haul fabricated steel components. Gondolas were ideal for this purpose due to their low center of gravity and ease of loading and unloading. They are equipped with roller bearing trucks

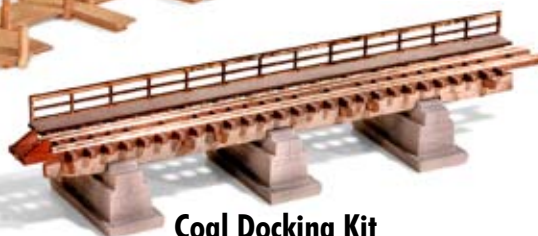

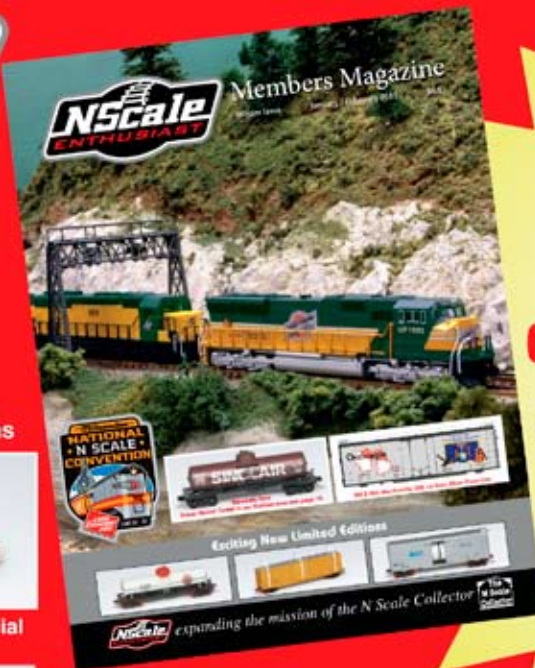

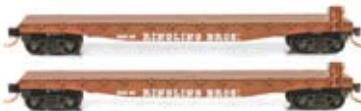
